

Establishment of Pakistan's First Ever Fabrication Lab with Support of MIT's FAB Foundation

Sukkur IBA University signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in early 2017 with MIT's FAB Foundation at its headquarters located in Boston, MA, USA to setup the country's first-ever Fabrication Laboratories (FAB Lab) at IBA-Institute of Emerging Technologies (IIET), Khairpur and Sukkur IBA University. FAB Lab (Fabrication Laboratory) is an interdisciplinary initiative by MIT's Centre for Bits and Atoms. The Fab Lab is a rapid prototyping platform and is meant to encourage local entrepreneurs, communities and learners to take their own ideas from the drawing board to prototypes in view of starting a local micro business, inventing a product or completing a class project. FAB Lab is currently training graduates for a 6-month 'Fab Academy Diploma in Digital Fabrication' program.



To motivate and inspire the students of engineering and computer science of various universities throughout Sindh, Sukkur IBA University organized competition under the title of SIBACOM 2017.



It is because of his love for science and technology that, he came up with the idea of developing a mobile science and technology lab, which can be driven to different government schools and colleges, where students can get benefit of the most modern laboratory at their doorsteps.


IBA University has taken yet another initiative of developing a Mobile Science and Technology Laboratory that will provide access to all our children to learn sciences, computer sciences and mathematics through the most recent inquiry, hands-on and problem based learning and teaching approaches, he remarked. In short, this mobile lab is going to prove a blessing for the students of schools and colleges throughout Upper Sindh, he added.



The mobile lab was established in collaboration with the Sindh government under Community Development Program at the cost of Rs. 15 million. Director CDC and Focal Person Community Development Program Ishfaque Ahmed Lashari briefing about the mobile science and technology lab, told that, ironically most of the government schools and colleges don't have or have non-functional science laboratories.

The VC says, Sukkur IBA University is an innovative STEM University which envisions to serve the community. He said, it is working for social and economic development of the community through the offering of high quality science education at Sukkur IBA University and its affiliated community colleges and schools. In order to promote and improve the quality of science teaching and learning in the schools throughout Sindh and Pakistan, Sukkur





This mobile science and technology lab is equipped with Physics, Chemistry and Biology sections and it will travel to different schools and colleges, where the students can conduct scientific experiments on their own with the help of the lab staff. MS. Uneaza Alvi, who is Assistant Professor at the Education Department of Sukkur IBA University and Project Lead, takes keen interest in such initiatives and the credit for materializing the dream of mobile lab goes to her. According to her, no nation can prosper without science and technology and therefore it is utmost




necessary to create awareness and love for science and technology among the students. She told that, initially we will focus on the students of middle schools from class VI to class VIII. Science laboratories cease to exist in most of the government schools and where there are science laboratories, there is acute shortage of science teachers, she said.

The only answer to this grave problem is the mobile science and technology lab, which can be moved to any destination, she added. She said, this mobile lab is a complete package for the science students.



She said, one such mobile lab is quite insufficient for entire Sindh and therefore I suggest there should be at least one such mobile lab for all six administrative units of Sindh.

Besides serving the purpose of most modern science laboratory, this mobile lab will also test water in different areas, which is a plus point, she added. Not only this, but the staff of the mobile lab will also teach the students and other people how to monitor blood pressure and to record temperature, she said. This will focus on Ghotki district with is being a focused district for the OGDCL.

Neuro Warfare 17 organized by CRC



2017. Under same program CEL&Inc. Sukkur IBA conducted training of beneficiaries from rural areas of Daharki and Ghotki.






