FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

It took more than two decades to turn Sukkur IBA University into what it is today. Never compromising on the quality, be it the building, classrooms, auditorium, library and other facilities, or the faculty and staff, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Nisar Ahmed Siddiqui, always craves for the best of the best.

Like other facilities, full attention is being paid to the faculty development program, under which dozens of lecturers and assistant professors are currently seeking their Post-doctorate, PhD, MS leading to PhD, and Masters in different subjects in various universities around the world on scholarship.

It is very difficult for any educational institution to hire PhD from outside, as they would like to dictate their own terms and conditions. Keeping in view these problems, the top management of Sukkur IBA University decided to send their own faculty members to pursue Post-doctorate, PhD, MS leading to PhD, and Masters in different universities of the world. The Chairman Higher Education Commission, Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed, during his visit to Sukkur IBA University in 2017, pointing to the acute shortage of PhDs in University system, said, "today, we have around 42000 faculty members in our university system (public and private both), of which only 11600 are PhD".

According to him, "we need at least 30000 more PhDs to run our university system smoothly. Sukkur IBA University is much fertile in terms of having PhDs in its faculty in various subjects in the field of Business, IT, Engineering, Mathematics and Education.






TABLE. 2 "FACULTY MEMBERS WHO ARE PURSUING THEIR STUDY LEAVE"

Workshop on Islamic Orientation



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
One Day workshop on Islamic Orientation for faculty & staff

MoU with Sapienza University, Italy



Test for Teaching & Non-Teaching Positions


The Human Resource Office at Sukkur IBA University conducted tests against various teaching and non-teaching positions, in which about 500 candidates appeared.
