
Sukkur IBA University Team Attended 2nd Exchanges Mechanism Conference in China


Sukkur IBA University Team Visited Jiangsu University, China

LET THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT MAKE YOU HAPPY

Energy requirements are rising with continuous increase in the population. Government of Pakistan is struggling hard to cope-up with the rising energy deficit, but unfortunately the gap between demand and supply is widening day by day.

Sensing the gravity of the situation, Sukkur IBA University taking step ahead, has included clean and renewable energy at its campus by installing solar panels, which produce 964 KWp of clean and renewable energy, thus minimizing the hazards to the already endangered environment told the Vice Chancellor Sukkur IBA University Prof. Nisar Ahmed Siddiqui in an exclusive interview.

He told that, in order to produce clean energy for better environment, Sukkur IBA University in collaboration with the Government of Sindh has installed grid tied

solar system of 964 KWp capacity. The system was installed by the consultants ELAN Partners through the contractor Nizam Energy. It is safe to say that, the system is the largest solar systems in Sukkur city as well as in any university in Pakistan.

Besides providing green and clean energy, he said, the system provides an opportunity to the students to have hands on experience to learn the latest technology, especially students enrolled in renewable energy system Engineering program of the university. In this way the university will not only be able to produce more qualified engineers, he went on saying, just recently we have signed an agreement with the SEPCO for supplying excess electricity to the utility through Net-Metering system, he informed.



He further told that, by producing around 150000 units per month, Sukkur IBA University is saving around more than Rs. one million per month. Total cost of the project is Rs. 116 million and its pay time is five years, he said adding, this system is capable of providing free of cost energy for more than 25 years. This project is supporting the environment with green energy initiative, emission of around 1300 tons of CO₂ per year in the environment

has been reduced, he informed. According to him, by

producing green energy, the university is saving 370000 liters of petroleum fuel annually.


The Vice Chancellor suggested to install solar panels upon the canals, running parallel to Sukkur IBA University. These

solar panels will serve dual purpose, one it will produce renewable energy and secondly due to cover, process of water evaporation will be slowed down, he

added. According to him, with this system, 74.76 KWp is being supplied to Academic Blocks-I, II & III, 53.97 KWp to the Administration Block, 79.8 KWp to the Mosque, Warehouse & Power House, 192.2 KWp to Girls Hostel I & II, 156.76 KWp to the Boys Hostel I & II, 69.16 KWp to the Knowledge Centre and 181.2 KWp to the Bus Parking Shade. And the total comes to 964 KWp.

Online monitoring of all the 40 inverters is being done on hourly basis. DC Cables from Helukable Germany have been installed for the system, which can work properly even in more than the temperature of 90 degrees Celsius.

The project was completed under the supervision of the Registrar Sukkur IBA University Engr. Zahid Hussain Khand, who ensures proper monitoring of the system on regular basis, said, switching over to clean and renewable energy has become imperative to overcome the challenges of climate change. Solar and wind energy are the sources of clean and renewable energy and have become utmost important to save the environment, making Pakistan clean, green and prosperous.



Eye Tracking - Behavioral Lab Workshop

An Eye Tracking - Behavioral Lab workshop was arranged at Sukkur IBA University, with the purpose to educate the Sukkur IBA University faculty regarding the implementation of the research being done through eye tracking in different industries and sectors. Other than training teachers, EDC also trained students for basic ICT skills. The 12-Day training program on Basic ICT Skills was conducted in various batches. The students of Govt. Naz Pilot Secondary School Khairpur, Govt. Girls High School Luqman, Khairpur and others benefitted from these trainings.

Another successful development of the initiative was the 5-day training on "Leadership – The Way Forward" for the principals & school heads of secondary and higher secondary schools of Khairpur District. During this training, Mr. Syed Asad Ali Shah, Former CEO Deloitte & Engagement Partner USAID, motivated all the teachers for positive change in their respective Government Schools through collaborative efforts. During the training, participants were introduced to various approaches, models, and theories of School Leadership and Management.

Certificate and Kits Distribution Ceremony for Candidates of CDP




Recruitment Test for Various Positions at Sukkur IBA University

Sukkur IBA Testing Services (STS) conducted the recruitment test for the positions of “Junior Clerk (BPS-11)” and “Stenographer (BPS-16)” for District & Sessions Court, Karachi. More than 600 applicants attempted the test.



STS Achievement of the Year: SELD Tests

SIBA Testing Services (STS) successfully conducted the recruitment test for the positions of Early Childhood Teacher (BPS-15) & Junior Elementary School Teacher (BPS-14) for Sindh Education and Literacy Department (SELD). The test for ECT was conducted in six cities including Sukkur, Hyderabad, Karachi, Larkana, Mirpurkhas, and Shaheed Benazirabad. The total number of applicants from all the centers combined was approximately 19,000.

The test for JEST was conducted in three parts with 40,000+ applicants. The first part of the test took place in six cities namely Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Mirpurkhas, and Shaheed Benazirabad. It was conducted on November 11, 2018. More than 16,000 applicants attempted the test.

The second part of the test was conducted in five different cities including, Hyderabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Mirpurkhas, and Shaheed Benazirabad on November 18, 2018. More than 13,000 applicants attempted the test.

The third part of the test was conducted in four different locations on November 25, 2018, which included, Public School Hyderabad, Pilot Public School Larkana, IBA Public School Sukkur, and Sukkur IBA University. More than 11,000 applicants attempted the test. Candidates were given carbon copies of their respective answer sheet. After the test scores were compiled and sent to education department for further processing.





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
